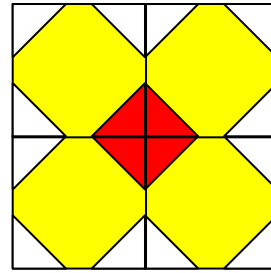


## Snowball Flower Block

Finished size: 6" square

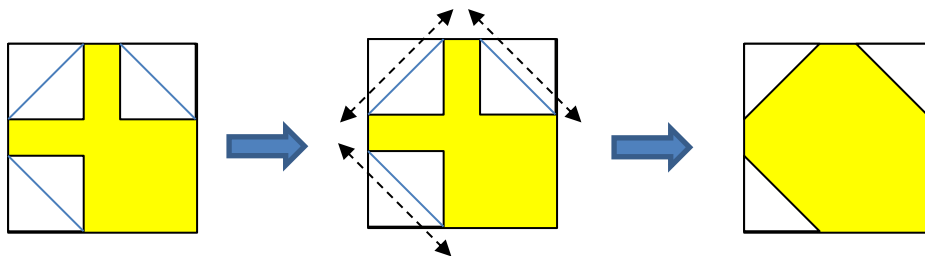


### Cutting Instructions:

- Main Colour: Four 3½" squares
- Background: Twelve 1½" squares
- Flower Centre: Four 1½" squares

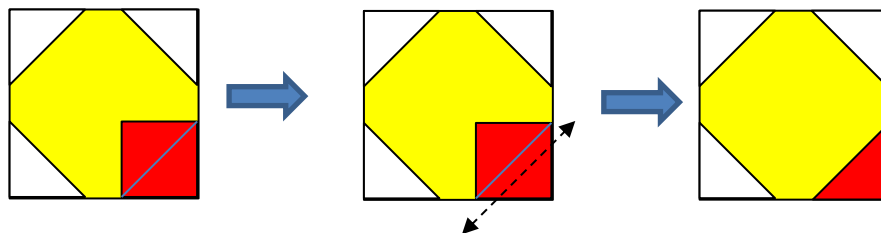
### Step 1

- Take three background squares. Draw a fine line from corner to corner diagonally across the back of each square.
- Position the squares right sides facing on a Main Colour square as illustrated.
- Stitch along each line.
- Using a rotary cutter cut through both layers of fabric a ¼" beyond the stitching. Press the seams open.



### Step 2

- Take a Flower Centre square and draw a fine line from corner to corner diagonally across the back. Place it on the remaining Main Colour corner of the Snowball unit and stitch along the line.
- Using a rotary cutter cut through both layers of fabric a ¼" beyond the stitching. Press the seam open.

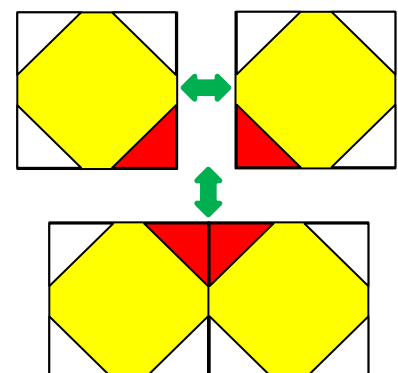


### Step 3

- Repeat **Steps 1 & 2** to make three more Snowball blocks.

### Step 4

- Assemble the units as shown, using pins to obtain accurate matching of seams. Press all seams open.
